TO ALL STATE DELEGATES, ALTERNATES AND CLUB SECRETARIES:

The meeting of the New York State Rabbit & Cavy Breeders Association will be held Sunday June 23, 2019 at the Dwyer Memorial County Park in Cortland, NY. The meeting is scheduled to begin at 2:00. We are also planning a picnic open to all NYRCBA members and their families to begin at noon the same day. Anyone wishing to participate in the picnic as well as the meeting is asked to bring their family, table settings and a dish to pass. The State will supply the meat, soda and bottled water. I need to know prior to the picnic how many to expect so please send me a note or call me to let me know how many will be attending. Directions to the park are below. If the assigned alternate or delegate from your club cannot make the meeting and you plan to send someone else to represent your Club, please remember I need a letter from your Club President giving that person permission to act as delegate for that day. Only Delegates or Alternate (if replacing the Delegate for meeting) will be allowed to participate in discussion during meeting. This will be strictly enforced.

The directions to the meeting place are as follows:

From the South take I-81 to Homer Exit 12. Turn right onto Rt. 281 North and go 6.0 miles. Right at Park sign into park.

From the North take I-81 to Preble Exit 13. Right onto Rt. 281 South and go 2.0 miles. Left at park sign into park.

Go straight into park from sign, about 0.4 miles. You will be going past a main pavilion, over creek, and will need to follow to the left just past horseshoe pits, children's playground and baseball diamond. Our pavilion will be seen from playground down by the lake and the basket ball courts. We will not have the same site as last year but will have the one down by the water that we have had in previous years. If you could please send me an e-mail that you will be attending and for which club, I would appreciate it!

The Charter Renewals were emailed to all Club Secretaries. Please return as soon as possible so I can get all the new show dates and changes recorded before our meeting. I have enclosed a copy of the New by law changes to be discussed.
