Show Rules

- 1. All Open & Youth rabbits for all shows will be judged by private ear number.**
 - 2. All rabbits must be permanently and legibly tattooed in left ear.**
 - 3. All carrying cages must have leak proof bottoms.**
 - 4. To avoid delays– the 3call rule will apply.**
 - 5. NCRCBA reserves the right to substitute judges if necessary.**
 - 6. Sick animals will be removed from showroom and entry fee will be forfeited.**
 - 7. Anyone causing a disturbance or trying to intimidate a judge will be asked to leave and their entry fee will be forfeited.**
 - 8. All returned checks will be charged a \$25.00 fee the first and second time they are deposited.**
 - 9. All children must be supervised.**
 - 10. No alcoholic beverages allowed in the show room or on the show grounds.**
 - 11. All awards must be picked up at the secretary's table by the end of the show. Nothing will be mailed out.**
 - 12. No dogs, cats, etc. will be allowed in the show room. You can have them on the show grounds and contained. Please pick up and dispose of waste.**
 - 13. Remark cards will not be used. You can bring them filled out and give to the writer. Then they have to fill it out for you.**
 - 14. Exhibitor must pick up check in sheets and check for corrections. NO CORRECTIONS WILL BE MADE AT THE JUDGING TABLE WITHOUT CONSENT OF THE SECRETARY.**
 - 15. We ask that everyone do their share to keep the floors and outdoor areas clean.**
- Respect the venue if you would like to have a show next year.**
