## Show Rules

1. All Open & Youth rabbits for all shows will be judged by private ear number.
  2. All rabbits must be permanently and legibly tattooed in left ear.
  3. All carrying cages must have leak proof bottoms.
  4. To avoid delays– the 3-call rule will apply.
  5. NCRCBA reserves the right to substitute judges if necessary.
  6. Sick animals will be removed from showroom and entry fee will be forfeited.
  7. Anyone causing a disturbance or trying to intimidate a judge will be asked to leave and their entry fee will be forfeited.
  8. All returned checks will be charged a \$25.00 fee the first and second time they are deposited.
  9. All children must be supervised.
  10. No alcoholic beverages allowed in the show room or on the show grounds.
  11. All awards must be picked up at the secretary's table by the end of the show. Nothing will be mailed out.
  12. No dogs, cats, etc. will be allowed in the show room. You can have them on the show grounds and contained. Please pick up and dispose of waste.
  13. Remark cards will not be used. You can bring them filled out and give to the writer. Then they have to fill it out for you.
  14. Exhibitor must pick up check in sheets and check for corrections. **NO CORRECTIONS WILL BE MADE AT THE JUDGING TABLE WITHOUT CONSENT OF THE SECRETARY.**
  15. We ask that everyone do their share to keep the floors and outdoor areas clean.
