1. All open and youth rabbits must have a permanent legible private ear number, cavies must be tagged and will only be judged by tag.
2. All animals shown at your own risk, RBFCF will not be held liable.
3. Exhibitors must pick up check in sheets and will have to verify entries at check in. Scratches will be done at tables with Show Secretary approval. Scratches will not be refunded. A \$25.00 charge will be added to any bounced checks.
4. This is a carrying case show. All carriers MUST have leakproof bottoms.
5. Remark cards will not be issued.
6. Exhibitors are responsible for getting rabbits to and from the show tables.
7. No changes are allowed unless approved by the Secretary and Superintendent.
8. No other animals are allowed on the show grounds. Only animals entered are allowed in the showroom. Wool areas must be cleaned by wool animal exhibitors.
9. ALL CHILDREN MUST BE SUPERVISED AT ALL TIMES BY AN ADULT. If an issue arises the children and adults will be told to leave and have their entries forfeited.
10. All prizes must be picked up by the end of the show. Only sanctioned breeds and breeds with over 8 entries are available to receive an award.
11. Any animals showing any signs of sickness will be removed from the showroom and entries forfeited.
12. RHD Rules will follow ARBA guidelines please no hay or shavings as bedding.

** We will have a youth event with Breed ID and judging of one class. Please reach out to the show superintendent on the day of the show to enter.
